▪ INTRODUCTION

Carl Gustav Jung's Theory Of Consciousness

Literature is a form of imagination expressed by the author into a work in the form of ideas that describe life. Nania's persistence in achieving her determination is one of the characteristics of the function of a thinking type soul. Nania has faced a lot of opposition regarding her marriage. Not to mention, she had to face whispers from people around her who looked down on her and her husband. If Nania is a sensitive person, she may not be able to bear the burden because her feelings are hurt. Nania actually remains optimistic and thinks positively because she loves Rafly. Mental Attitude
